
Electoral College

- Each state has <u>votes for</u>
 <u>president equal to its</u>
 <u>number of Senators and</u>
 <u>its number of</u>
 <u>Representatives in the</u>
 <u>House.</u>
- Example: California
 - 2 Senators
 - 53 Representatives
 - 55 Electoral Votes for president



Why does California have 55 Electoral votes for president?

Electoral Vote

- The Electoral College (vote) has 538 total electoral votes spread across the 50 states and Washington D.C.
- To win the presidency, <u>a</u> candidate needs to win at least 270 electoral votes.




• Why are there 538 total electoral votes for the presidency?


2020 Election:



The Big State Rip Off

- California
- Population: 37 million
- Electoral votes: 55
- Divide 37,000,000 by 55
 - Answer: 672,727
- Wyoming
- Population: 545,000
- Electoral votes: 3
- Divide 545,000 by 3
 - Answer: 181,667
