




The Federal System

• The Constitution set up a system in which power is shared between the national government and the individual states.

The National (Federal) Government:

- President, Congress, Courts
- The State Government:
 - Governor, Legislature, Courts

The Preamble

- We the People of the United States,
- Ordinary Americans will
- in order to form a more perfect Union,
- create a <u>stronger nation</u> by having the states unite and <u>cooperate</u>,
- establish Justice,
- create <u>laws</u> that apply to everyone <u>equally</u>,
- insure domestic tranquility,
- create peace and order within the nation,
- provide for the common defense,
- protect America from foreign attack,
- promote the general welfare,
- create an economy in which people can <u>succeed</u> and help society for the <u>common good</u>,

The Preamble

- and secure the blessings of liberty to ourselves and our posterity,
- and make sure Americans have <u>freedom</u> now and in the <u>future</u>,
- do ordain and establish this Constitution for the United States of America.
- do <u>create</u> this Constitution for the United States of America.



A Separation of Powers

- The 3 branches of the government <u>separate</u> power between Congress, the President, and the Court System.
- This creates a system of checks and balances
- Each branch <u>limits the</u> <u>power of the other</u> branches.

On the left is the <u>House of Representatives</u>.


Representative from Burbank

- The House part of Congress has 435 members from the 50 states.


