- America received help from <u>France and Spain</u>.
- George Washington was leader of the Continental Army.

- Weaknesses:
- Britain had to <u>move</u> supplies 3,000 miles across the Atlantic.
- British citizens were unhappy with the war.
- British generals had poor leadership skills and made major mistakes.
- Strengths:
- Britain had a professional,
 army of soldiers and mercenaries.
- The British army was well supplied within America.
