The main problem causing tension between the sections of the United States was slavery. This became more apparent in the 1800s as America gained territory in the west. The North and the South engaged in bitter debates about the expansion of slavery into the new territories, and a series of compromises failed to solve the issue. Eventually, arguments about the power of the federal government to control the movement of slaves and a state's rights to dictate its own policy about slavery led to more tension. Slavery was a constant weight undermining America's growth, and soon tore the nation apart.
